

How will the school prepare and support my child to join a new school?

Nursery children attend for 2 shorter sessions at the start of the term to help them settle and allow staff time to get to know them and their parents.

The nursery children attend the reception class for three sessions in the summer term which allows them to become familiar with the school setting. There is also a shortened school day during the first week of school in September. Induction meetings are planned for parents to meet the staff and for sharing relevant information.

Year two children will attend their feeder school for two days in the summer term. Parents and children will have an opportunity to meet with their child's new teacher from the junior school. We also provide additional transition days for specific children who need this. Photographs may be taken to remind children of their new surroundings.
