History

(History topics are covered over a two year cycle)

- Experience aspects of the lives of people in the past focusing on a specific community of people.
- Ask and answer questions about the past using a range of historical sources
- Make their own historical representation or interpretation of a specific person or event.
- Develop empathy through role play

Art and Design

- Experience and investigate changing materials such as clay and salt dough, papier mache
- Respond to the visual and tactile qualities and texture of materials and select appropriate materials, tools and techniques to develop their ideas.
- Explore shape, form and space in 3D- clay
- Create portraits of self and others

Design Technology

- Experience changing materials and know that they change
- Investigate, explore and experience common materials and tools by sequencing actions and finding alternatives
- Make a plan and use appropriate tools to fulfil their design criteria, listing equipment and materials required
- Try out ideas by shaping materials and putting components together, using equipment safely
