PE Games and Hall time:

PSHE

English:

Children will immerse themselves in all things Hans Christian Anderson.

Children will:

- Create stories from illustrations found in Hans Christian Anderson novels
- Write a book review about a Hans Christian Anderson novel.
- Write a biography of Hans Christian Anderson.

We will continue to practice our grammar, punctuation and spellings.

History/Geography:

Children will be exploring Europe and locating different countries and their capitals. Children will be looking specifically at Denmark and its physical and human aspects. We will also use co-ordinates to locate key geographical features in Denmark. The children will then use this knowledge to create a travel brochure that compares Bristol to Copenhagen.

ICT:

This term we will be learning how IT supports meteorologists in measuring and predicting the weather. We will interrogate large databases of weather information and make our own weather forecasts

Science:

Children will investigate liquids, solids and gases. They will also investigate evaporation and condensation.

French:

Children will learn how to correctly pronounce countries and capitals of Europe in French. They will also ask and respond to questions about where they are going on holiday.

Maths:

- Solving multiplication and division calculations through using appropriate methods.
- Children will explore fractions and their equivalent decimals.
- During environment week we will be exploring different ways to show data.
- During Sports week children will be solving problems involving time.
