

Pupil Premium

The Pupil Premium is allocated to the following groups of children:

- Children from low-income families who are currently known to be eligible for Free School Meals (FSM) in both mainstream and non-mainstream settings.
- Children who have been eligible for FSM in the last 6 years (ever6).
- Children who have been looked after (LAC) continuously for one day or more.
- Children who were adopted on or after 30th December 2005 or left care under a special guardianship order or residence order.
- Children from the armed forces.



Level of premium per child for 2015-16:

FSM & Ever 6- £1320 looked after children (LAC) & Adopted children - £1900 Service children- £300 EYPP - £300

Impact of Pupil Premium

Since the introduction of Pupil Premium, Frithwood's FSM pupils have been a clear, relative strength in terms of attainment and progress at the end of KS2. Their attainment and progress has been consistently above our school's non-FSM pupils and national all pupils. They have also been significantly above FSM pupils nationally (please see separate link for comprehensive KS2 data). **Highlights for 2015 FSM pupils include:**

Year 6 SATs

- Reading Level 4+ 92% (national FSM 83%; national all pupils 89%)
- Writing Level 4+ 83% (national FSM 79%; national all pupils 87%)
- SPAG Level 4+ 100% (national FSM 71%; national all pupils 80%)
- Maths Level 4+ 92% (national FSM 80%; national all pupils 87%)
- R+W+M Level 4+ 75% (national FSM 70%; national all pupils 80%)
- Reading 2 Levels Progress 100% (national FSM 88%; national all pupils 91%)
- Writing 2 Levels Progress 100% (national FSM 92%; national all pupils 94%)
- Maths 2 Levels Progress 100% (national FSM 86%; national all pupils 90%)

FSM Average Point Score (APS) Progress 2014-15 (average of Reading, Writing and Maths)

- Year 6 3.4
- Year 5 3.5
- Year 4 4.0
- Year 3 5.1

3.5+ points progress in a year is considered good/v.good progress

Year 2 SATS – APS (Average Points Score)

- All subjects 15.4 (national FSM 14.8)
- Reading 15.9 (national FSM 15.2)
- Writing 14.4 (national FSM 14.0)
- Maths 15.9 (national FSM 15.2)

Forces Pupils
