**Trips**

I understand that occasionally during my child's time at Ashley C of E Primary School, classes will be taken on school trips to enrich the learning. These visits are those which take place during the normal course of the school day, for example, on foot to places within the local area, taking the train to London, or a coach trip to a museum or place of interest.

The School will send information to parents about each trip before it takes place.

I will tell the School if I do not want my child to take part in any particular school trip.

## Photography and the use of images

During the course of the school year there may be opportunities to publicise some of the activities that your child is involved in. This may involve photographing or occasionally filming children for use in the media.

There may also be occasions when we arrange photography for our own purposes, such as displays and the sharing of learning on the School website.

In deciding whether or not it is appropriate to allow the use of photography and/or video, it is important to ensure the protection of the children in our care.

Photography or filming will only take place with the permission of the Headteacher, and under the supervision of a member of staff. When photography or filming is carried out by the media, children will only be named, by first name, if there is a particular reason to do so (e.g. when they have won a prize).

When parents/carers attend events and performances within the School, any photos or video you take of your child, which include other people's children must be for your own personal use. These **MUST NOT** be published on the web/internet, in particular social media websites such as Facebook, unless you have expressly sought and obtained prior consent from each of the child/children's parents or guardians. This is an especially important precaution to protect the privacy and safety of families who may have complex family circumstances.
