

St Teresa's School Sports Council minutes – Thursday 11th February 2016

Present: Harry and Klara (Y1), Ruva and Tomasz (Y2), Fiona and Conor (Y3), Thomas and Gabriells (Y4), Alice (Y5), Zona and Neave (Y6), Mr Lofting, Mrs Tucker.

Mrs Tucker reminded school council about what was discussed and agreed at the last meeting (26th October 2015):

It was agreed that behaviour at playtime is still greatly improved from last year although most Sports Council Reps felt that some children were not following the rules and these needed to be re-established.

In particular, rotas are not being stuck to; equipment is not being looked after and is sometimes used inappropriately.

Year 3 reps felt that they no longer had enough equipment as other classes often helped themselves to their equipment. This was because their class name had rubbed off.

Actions

- 1. Sports Council Reps to ask their classes to rate themselves on how good they are at looking after equipment.**
- 2. Sports Council Reps to remind their classes of the equipment rules and discuss if any need changing. Classes to also be reminded of rotas.**
- 3. Equipment to be re-audited, reorganised and re marked next half term. A laminated list of contents will then be made for each bag. School Sports Council reps to attend a meeting on Thursday 25th February, bringing a list of all the items in their bags.**
- 4. One football for each key stage is to be kept centrally by Mr Lofting/Martina. The class for a particular day needs to get this football from Mr Lofting/Martina.**
- 5. Mr Tucker to purchase a set of permanent markers (a different colour for each class). Every Friday, reps then responsible for making sure items are still clearly marked.**
- 6. Reps to ask class about games they would like Mr Lofting to teach them and report back on the 25th February.**
