PARENT CARER CONSULTATIONS

Are you a parent carer of a child/ young person aged 0-25 years with Special Educational Needs and/ or Disabilities (SEND) in Wiltshire?

If so, the Wiltshire Parent Carer Council and Wiltshire Council, would like to invite you to attend a consultation on the draft Wiltshire Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND) Strategy for Children and Young People aged 0-25 (2016-19).

The vision of the strategy is all about working towards:-

"The right provision in the right place at the right time to achieve the best possible outcomes for children and young people with special educational needs and/ or disability."

It sets out the key priorities for SEND provision and support in Wiltshire, including: parent carer participation, children and young people's voice and influence, The Local Offer, SEND Service, Short Breaks, health services, early years, preparing for adulthood, autism, SEND transport, and SEND funding. The strategy will sit alongside the 'Wiltshire SEN Strategy Supporting Schools 2015-18' which covers educational provision.

This is a really important opportunity to have a say about the Strategy vision and priorities for action.

During the day there will be a presentation, followed by discussion/ informal workshops. If you would like to get involved, please book your place by **5pm on Thursday 3rd March 2016**.
