We are having a Crucial Crew visit to the Lifewise Centre at Hellaby on 22nd April. More information about the day will follow nearer the time.

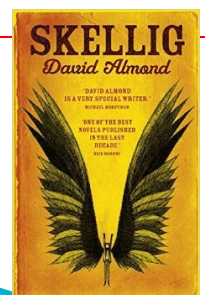


Easter
