Parents' Questionnaire

18% of questionnaires were returned to us and we received a reassuring response to our questions. In your opinion, 88% felt safe in school with 91% feeling happy. 94% of parents felt that their children received an education within their ability and 95% felt that their children should received every opportunity to be bilingual. The children's questionnaire showed similar results with 92% saying that they felt happy and safe in school and 85% stated that they felt they were being treated fairly. School Uniform Policy

- Grey or Black trousers – no jeans please
- Grey or Black skirt
