

### LITERACY & DRAMA:

This term our literacy lessons will be based on our topic of The Seaside!

We will be:

Creating our own story of a seaside adventure featuring Katie Morag.

Writing rules to follow at the beach.

Recounting fictional dreams that have taken place at the beach.

Writing a brochure about a holiday destination

In SPAG we will be revising the learning we have done so far in Year 2.

### MATHS:

In maths, we will be revising a lot of our maths skills in preparation for SATs:

We will be:

-Recapping measure: length, capacity and mass.

-Exploring 2d and 3d shapes.

-Revising time and money.

-Recapping our number work with addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

### PSHE:

This term in PSHE we are continuing to follow the new programme of learning called 'Jigsaw'.

In our Jigsaw lessons we will be following the theme of 'relationships'. Each session is called a 'piece', and we will be exploring the following pieces:

-Families

-Keeping safe

-Friends and conflict

-Secrets

-Trust and appreciation

### MUSIC:

This term in music we will be exploring instruments and symbols.

We will be:

Identifying and using instruments in songs

Explore how symbols can be used to represent vocal sounds

Explore how symbols can be used to represent instrumental

### PE:

In indoor PE, we will be exploring agility, through movements on the floor and also on apparatus.

In outdoor PE we will be taking part in Striking and Fielding activities, as well as having a go at developing our Frisbee skills!

This term Year 2 will be investigating the seaside. Our topic lessons will be based on the following key learning objectives:

Create a beach painting/collage

Measure and record temperature

Tell you about seaside jobs

Create sand art

Use perspective in my drawings

Identify how to keep beaches clean

Tell you what people do at the seaside

Create a seaside brochure

Sort between natural and man-made beach objects

Compare beach experiences past and present

### RE:

We will be exploring the question "Where do we belong?"

Learning Objectives:

Understand where we belong and talk about things that happen to me

Understand who makes up our family and understand the family Jesus belonged to

Understand why Shabbat is important to the Jewish faith

Understand why the prayer mat is important to the Muslim faith

Consider what it means to be part of a family

Discuss how people show where they belong



### ICT:

This term in our computing lessons, Year 2 are going to be learning all about using email safely. The children will be allocated an email address which will work only for sending email internally within the school. We will be:

Developing skills in opening, composing and sending emails

Opening and listening to audio files

Using appropriate language in emails

Being aware of 'e' safety issues when using email
