Pre-school staff would like to make you aware of the topic we are covering this term which is space, so far the children have been making their own rockets, moon pictures and space writing.

Throughout the next 6 weeks your child may get involved in alien handprints, making planets out of papier-mâché, and other space and spring related activities.

As part of our topic space we will be covering the book "Whatever Next" and the children will have the opportunity to help with making a chimney, a spaceship out of a cardboard box and their own moons and stars for our "Whatever Next" display board. We will also be looking at the story book "Aliens I Love Underpants" and other books relating to space.



St George's Day is on Friday the 22nd April. To celebrate this, your child may get involved in making their own flags.

To get your child used to going into nursery, we are introducing a structured routine; your child will now have a name card with a picture on, there will be a plastic tub with your child's water bottle inside. Please help your child to look for their name and coat peg when you arrive for their session? At group time we are going to also introduce days of the week, and the weather. This is something that you could also do at home with your child.

We will also be looking at numbers, colours and shapes in small groups at snack time. To help and support your child you can make it fun by counting the stairs at home, looking at the stars at night and looking at the shape of the moon.
