Dear Parents,

Firstly, thank you to those of you who have been making sure that your child is bringing their reading book every day and their spelling book on a Friday, it is helping support your child access further intervention and adult support in school.

Following some confusion around the new homework grid, please find below some tips on how to use the grid with your child.

The grid is to be used as a choice board, it is expected that your child completes at least one of the activities from each 'Area of Study'; the activity which they choose has a point in the column above it. The minimum expectation is for each child to accrue at least 20 points by the end of each half term. How the child achieves the 20 points is their choice, so long as they have completed at least one activity from each area.

A homework book will be sent out for the children to do their homework in – they can either write/draw straight into the book or stick in any information they have found or researched. If your child could bring in their homework book fortnightly (on a Friday) for the teachers to check, that would be really helpful. We are currently waiting for the new homework books to be delivered and will be given to the children as soon as they arrive. Staff are aware that this is a short half term as the homework grids have only recently been sent home, so if we could start from next Friday (13th May) to bring books in.

We are also aware Year 6 have been given a project to complete so the information above does not relate to them.

We appreciate your support and look forward to seeing the homework.
