It is with great pleasure that we are now able to tell you the results of the final Ofsted report from the inspection in June 2014. We apologise for the delay - this was out of our control.

Morden Mount is now '**a good school with outstanding features**' – a remarkable improvement from 'failing' 2 years ago.

Some edited highlights:

Pupils' achievement has improved markedly since the last inspection.

The quality of teaching is good and some is exemplary. Much is expected from pupils and their learning is always made interesting.

Pupils are now making rapid and sustained progress across the school so attainment is above the national average.

The most able achieve well – they are particularly proficient in maths and writing.

Children in the Early Years Foundation Stage make a positive start to the school. They share in a variety of tasks which develop their basic literacy and numeracy skills well.

The EYFS is calm and purposeful. Children happily play and learn well together and listen carefully to what adults say.

SEND pupils are very successful in their learning because of the effective support they receive during lessons and the individual help provided when needed.

The behaviour of pupils is outstanding. Pupils show exceptionally positive attitudes toward their learning. They concentrate in all their tasks and are eager to do well.

Pupils show respect for each other and their teachers, and have a mature approach in everything they do or talk about. They are exceptionally polite

The school's work to keep pupils safe and secure is outstanding. Pupils feel safe at all times and that the school is very friendly. Parents confirm they are happy.

The leadership and management are outstanding. The executive headteacher has brought about marked improvements.

All leaders are very effective in ensuring pupils are successful across a range of subjects.

Governors make an exceptional contribution to the school's development.

Provision for sport is particularly strong

Provision for pupils' spiritual, moral, social and cultural experience is exemplary

The school is well placed to improve even further.

We have already addressed Ofsted's suggestions for improvement with maths and grammar results above/well above national. We are looking forward to exceptional results summer 2015, making achievement and teaching outstanding as well!
