VOLUNTEER COMMITMENT

Most of our Primary Programmes last around 5 hours and involve fun, practical games, exercises and workshops that introduce young people to business at a young age.

Timings are flexible and sessions can be delivered a number of ways, for example:

- Half-day Seminars
- Two days at 2.5 hours each day
- Weekly 1 hour sessions

PROGRAMME GUIDE

OURSELVES (P1/2)

Through story-book characters pupils learn about the 'world of work' and the importance of saving, earning, decision making and teamwork.

OUR FAMILIES (P2/3)

Pupils identify family members and learn about the basic living needs and wants that they have.

OUR COMMUNITY (P3/4)

Pupils are led through a discovery of how people and businesses operate within a community.

BUSINESS BEGINNINGS (P5/7)

The Business Beginnings programme allows young people to get real business experience by setting up and running their own company. The programme gives insight into business in the real world.

OUR CITY (P4/5)

Pupils identify the main features of a city. They learn the jobs and skills of workers in key industries.

OUR NATION (P5/6)

Pupils are guided in understanding how a nation works and the different responsibilities of government and individuals.

OUR WORLD (P5/6)

Pupils learn what countries of the world rely on each other for resources.
