





Kirkdale, St Lawrence Code of Conduct



Code of Conduct: Traffic Light System

Black Area: School Zone

All children's names start here at the beginning of the each school day.

First incident of misbehaviour will be given a verbal warning and told clearly that if they persist they will be moved to 'thinking zone'.

If the misbehaviour persists then the child will be moved to green zone.

Green Zone

Examples of misbehaviour leading to green zone are:

- Disrespect to an adult (answering back, cheek)
- Defacing school property including desks, books etc.

If the child's bad behaviour continues they are given a further warning and told that if they do not alter their behaviour they will be moved to amber zone and given a suitable sanction.

Amber Zone

Examples of misbehaviour leading to amber zone are:

- Fighting (direct to amber)
- Repeated green incidents after warnings.

A child will then be told that if their behaviour persists they will be moved to red zone.

Red Zone

A child in the red zone will be sent to either HT or DH. If a child has three red zones parents will be asked to come into school to discuss behaviour with a member of the SMT and the SENCO, to initiate a report card system to be completed at school and home daily for a given period, usually one month.

Direct Red Zone

- Persistent bullying
- Swearing
- Violence towards an adult.

Congratulations!

If a child does not enter any zone apart from school zone all week they will be rewarded with a thank you certificate.

Alongside the traffic light display in class the 4 key elements of our code of conduct are displayed.
