Practice reading tricky words with your child. There are good games to play on www.letters-and-sounds.com

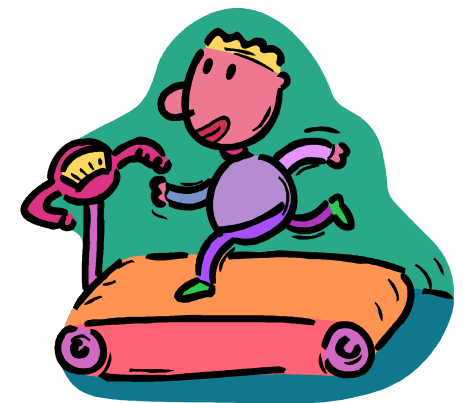
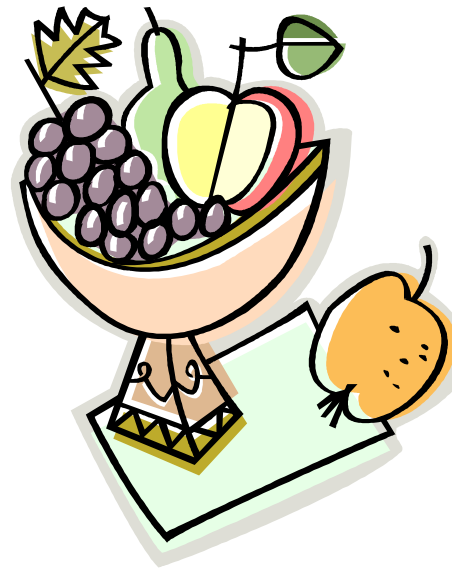

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning to:

- Show sensitivity to others' needs.
- Adjust our behaviour to different situations, and take changes of routine in our stride.

Communication and Language

We will be learning to:

- Give attention to what others say and respond appropriately, while engaged in another activity.
- Develop our own narratives and explanations by connecting ideas or events.

Physical Development

We will be learning to:

- Handle tools, objects, construction and malleable materials safely and with increasing control.
- Practice some safety measures without direct supervision.

Understanding the World

We will be:

- Talking about other children not always enjoying the same things and being sensitive to this.
- Making observations of ourselves, animals and plants and explain why some things occur.
- Selecting and using technology for particular purposes.

Literacy

We will be learning to:

- Know that information can be retrieved from books and computers.
- Write simple sentences that can be read by ourselves and others.
- Create stories.

Maths

We will be learning to:

- Consolidate understanding and using everyday language to talk about weight, distance, time and money.
- Explore characteristics of everyday objects and shapes and use mathematical language to describe them.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be:

- Safely using and exploring a variety of materials, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function.
- Representing own ideas through art, music, role play and stories.
