Pupils, parents and staff were all asked for their views and the following list was compiled. We attempted to make the list as short as possible and to phrase the rules in positive tones - do's instead of long lists of don'ts. The question was again put to parents in January 2003 and in 2009 when the policy was revised. We are undertaking the same review in 2014. Please let us know what you think.

- ◆ Keep hands and feet to yourself.
- ◆ Do as adults within school tell you.
- ◆ Always work to the best of your ability.
- ◆ Listen to teachers and other children while they are speaking. (Put your hand up if you want to talk to the teacher or class).
- ◆ Move around the school quietly and sensibly. Keep to the left in corridors and do not run.
- ◆ Call children by their first names.
- ◆ Come to school in uniform and always try to be clean and smart.
- ◆ No jewellery - studs are allowed but must be removed for P.E, Games and swimming.
- ◆ Only bring toys or belongings into school if your teacher has asked you to. "Swapping" causes arguments and is not allowed in school.
- ◆ Plain crisps, toast and fruit are the only snacks allowed at break.
- ◆ Be proud of your school. Treat each other, visitors and the building with respect.
