## Maths Homework

We have had lots of comments about the new online homework system. Thank you for your support and we are glad that children are enjoying their maths! Please save up your views ready for a questionnaire once the system has been running. We will review changes etc. then. We know many parents want more games and we will arrange this when we have worked out how to set them without requiring children to use skills they have not yet been taught or understood. A reminder that the most

important skill in maths is to have the basic tools at your disposal. This means Number bonds (e.g.  $7 + 2 = 9$ ) in Foundation Stage and Y1. The 2x, 3x and 10 x table mastered by end of Y2; 3x, 4x and 8x by end of Y3 and all tables up to 12x12 by end of Y4.
