Estuary Class trip to Stratford-Upon-Avon Monday 22nd February 2016

As part of our Shakespeare topic this term, we have organised a trip for Estuary Class to visit Stratford-Upon-Avon on Monday 22nd February 2016.

In this half day play building workshop the children will help actors to assemble a script.

Following a trail through Shakespeare's birth place, children discover clues to locate the pieces of a script. However, there is still work to do to assemble the story in the correct order and help the actors to perform it. During this session pupils will:

- Learn about the narrative structure of a play
- Encounter unfamiliar vocabulary and gain confidence in inferring meaning from context
- Bring Shakespeare's language to life by creating musical and dramatic contexts for his words
- Work with a team of professional actors and have the opportunity to perform with them at one of our beautiful historic houses.

This session is led by experienced teachers and actors working together to create a fun, interactive experience. Enhancing literacy and empowering pupils, this workshop will inspire pupils to explore and understand Shakespeare's language.

Our bus will be departing at 8.15am so children should be in school by 8am. Children should wear their school uniforms. Parts of the trip will take place outdoors so it is essential that your child has suitable clothing (coat, hat, gloves etc.)

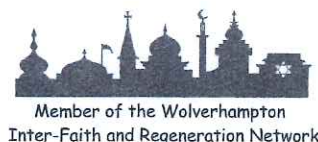
Any child we have registered as asthmatic must take an inhaler with them.
