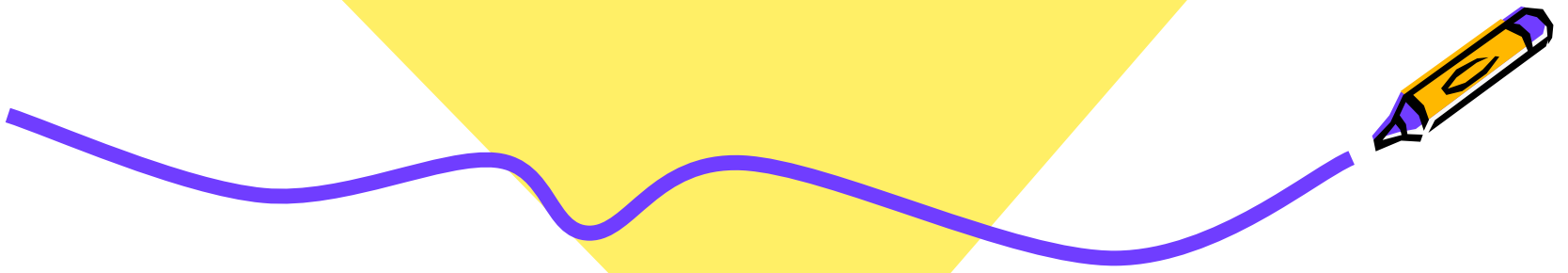

Start of school day



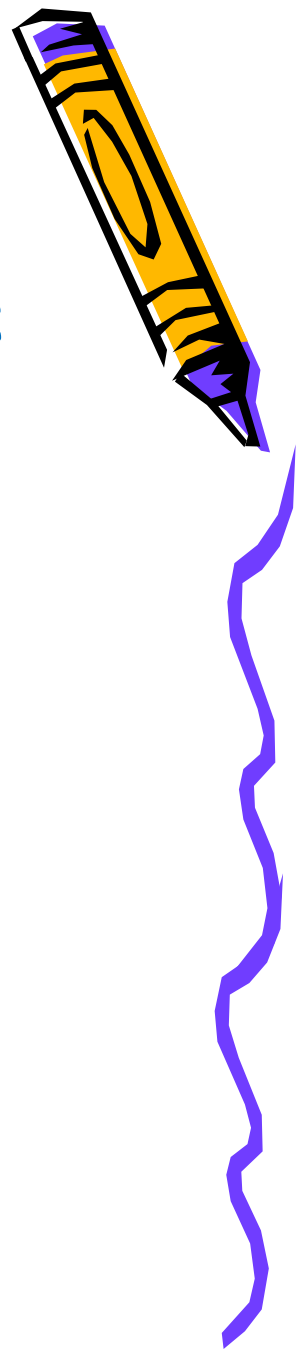
- Children to be in school promptly and organised.

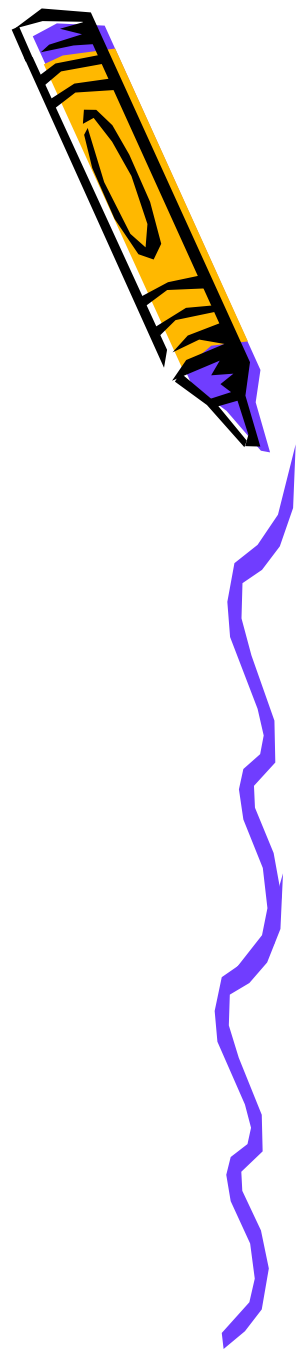

Reading



- Reading books must be in school every day.
- Please still try to hear your child read at home. Remember to write in their reading record when you've heard them read and sign when they have finished their book.
- If you can, remember to ask questions to check their understanding of the story.

Maths/English/Science

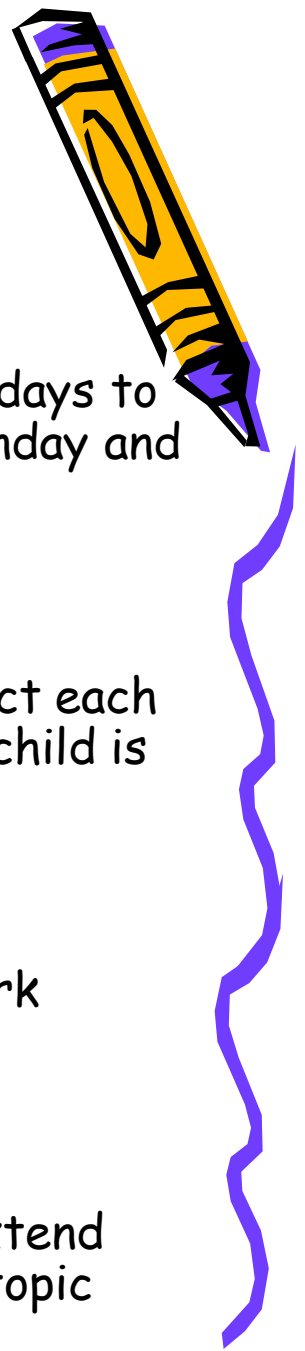
Children will be set a formal piece of homework from a core subject each week; this will be set on Friday and due in on Monday. If your child is unable to complete it please send in a note.

- School P.E. Kit is now available.



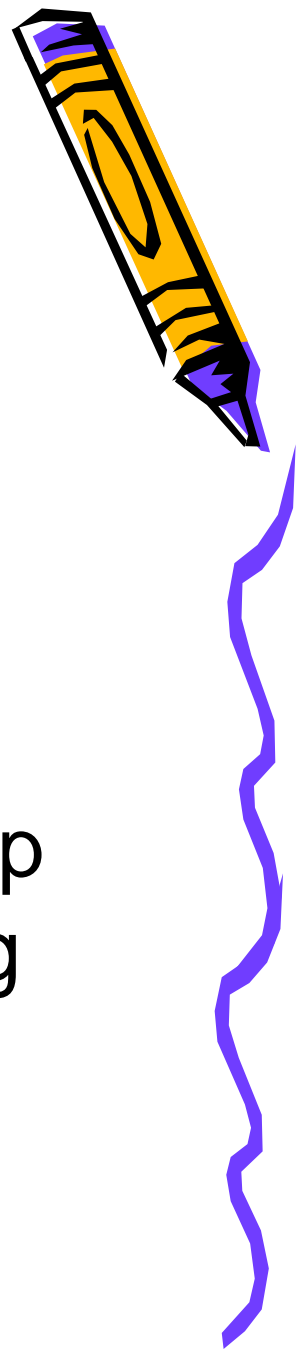
- No nail varnish or tattoos!

- Medicines should be handed in at the office and a form filled out.

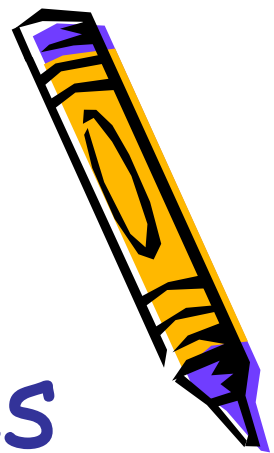


Playtime snacks and drinks
