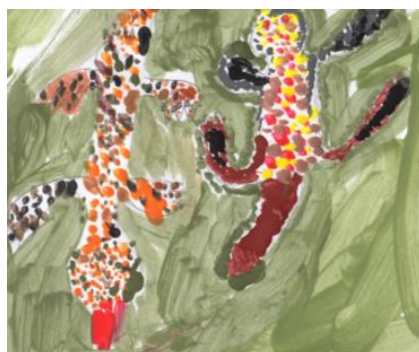
The Early Years extension has been open this week. It has already made a big difference to the learning environment.
