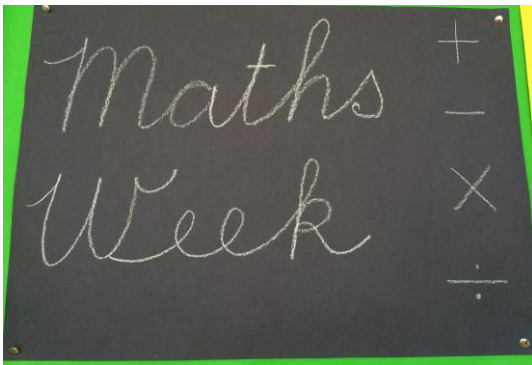

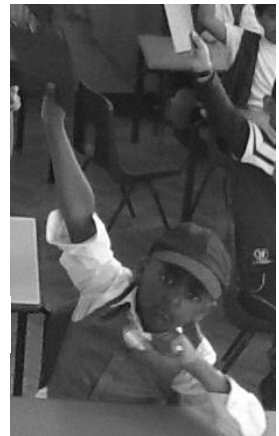
We Won! *Easter Bonnet Competition*
