

English, Drama and RWI:

This term our English lessons will be based on:
Using adjectives to describe Captain Beastlie and the story setting.
Using instructions to create a healthy pirate party food.
Exploring and retelling the traditional story of "Peter Pan".
Making our own Pirate Glossaries.

RE:

We will be exploring the question "Why is our World Special" by:
Exploring feelings about different aspects of the world around us.
Exploring the creation story and asking questions about creation.
Understanding the Hindu and Muslim creation story.
Comparing similarities and differences between different versions of creation.
Harvest Celebrations.

PSHE:

This term in PSHE Jigsaw sessions, we will be exploring the topic 'Being me in my World'. Our value is Respect.
Our sessions will explore:
-Our hopes and fears for the year.
-Rights and responsibilities.
-Rewards and consequences.
-Our Learning Charter.

Maths:

We will be developing our maths skills by:
Rounding numbers to the nearest 10 and 100.
Recognising and continuing number sequence patterns.
Multiplying numbers using repeated addition.
Dividing numbers by sharing equally.
Using weighing scales to find how many g/kg an object weighs
Finding $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{3}$ of a shape and a number
Telling o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to times.



Topic/ Science/ Art and Design:

Our topic this term is "Pirate Party Planners". We will be learning about pirates, healthy eating and learning about the artist Carl Warner.
We will be going on an interesting trip aboard the Matthew, and enjoying a pirate experience.
In our topic lessons we will be:
Designing a treasure map
Creating our own "foodscape" in the style of Carl Warner
Creating our own pirate "self"
Planning a pirate party
Our science topic this term will be exploring healthy eating, as well as investigating solids and liquids.
In our lessons we will be:
Designing and making a healthy recipe.
Exploring solids and liquids.
Finding out where food comes from.
Understanding the benefits of healthy eating and exercise.

PE:

We will be developing key skills in PE this term, with a focus on our rounder's skills.

Computing:
