

66 Table Facts

Introduction

We have introduced 66 table facts across school.

In the New Curriculum children need to know all table facts up to 12×12 (and related divisions) by the end of Year 4.

The idea behind 66 table facts is to promote the Commutative Law.

If children know 3×4 they also know 4×3 .

Progression

The facts children need to know are progressive starting from Year 2.

By the end of year 2 children should know off by heart the 2, 5 and 10 x tables and related divisions.

By the end of year 3 children should know off by heart the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 x tables and related divisions.

By the end of year 4 children should know off by heart all tables to 12×12 and related divisions.

At school

Children will use the relevant sheet to practice their tables, where they will be able to see their scores improving and use their knowledge of the table facts in other areas of maths.

Children will be tested on their tables on a regular basis to promote their importance and help support their progress.
