Foundation Stage F1 and F2



Welcome to our new F1 starters and welcome back to our current F1 children. Also a big well done to our new F2 children for settling into their routines quickly.

Our theme for this half term will be 'Ourselves and other children'. This will include learning about ourselves, our families and extended families, family celebrations and children around the world. After the half term break we will be investigating Colour and Pattern as our theme leading into the Christmas celebrations. We will continue to use all areas of learning both inside and outside to enhance our play and learning. As we will be exploring outside everyday, could all children please bring clothing and footwear suitable for the day's weather.

In Literacy we will be continuing with our Phonics and Letters and Sounds activities daily.

In order to enhance communication and language skills, much of our discussion will be centred around family and home events. Children may bring in a photograph of themselves and their family to discuss and display.

Stories are a very important part of our learning and will be included in each focus week within the theme with follow up activities included.

Our number activities will continue daily along with small group challenges. In order to assist your child with number recognition parents may encourage children to look for numbers all around them and in the environment.

We will also be looking at simple 2D shapes.
