Year 3/4: Classes 5 and 6



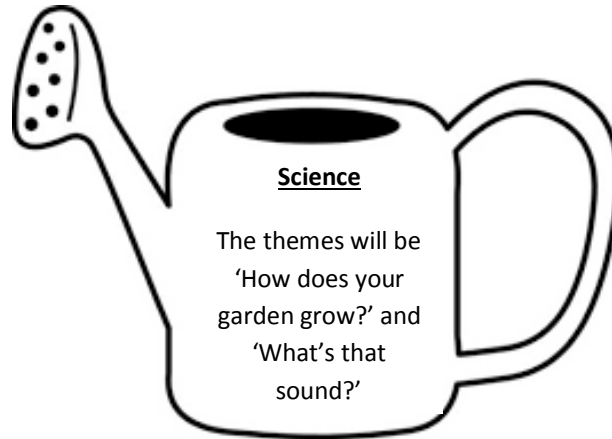
History

Both classes will be studying World War II in history, with a main focus on The Blitz, Evacuees, Rationing and Life on the Home Front.



Art and D.T.

In Art we will be looking at relationships, which links with our PSHCE topics of relationships and personal development.
Our D.T. topic will focus on moving models using pneumatics.



Science

The themes will be 'How does your garden grow?' and 'What's that sound?'

RE

In R.E. we will be studying celebrations and religious festivals.

Reading

In KS2, children will not read their reading book to an adult every day as we are aiming to develop more independent readers. It is therefore still important to hear your child read at home when you get the opportunity.

PE

Class 5 – Wednesday and Thursday
Class 6 – Thursday and Friday

Please ensure a full change of kit is available with a change of footwear. For outdoor lessons (Thursdays) children may also bring tracksuit bottoms and warm top such as a sweatshirt or hooded jumper. Jewellery should be removed or covered with tape.

Key Information

In Year 3 and 4, homework consists of a weekly spelling sheet and daily reading. Children should also regularly practice their times tables and occasionally additional maths work may be sent home if teachers feel this is necessary. Mathletics, an online resource, can also be used for children to practice general maths skills and work may be set for children using this resource.

This term, a key objective for all our children (particularly the year 3's) will be to develop and make the children as independent as possible, so it would be appreciated if you could encourage your child to enter school on their own and generally get themselves organised independently.
