



Holme on Spalding Moor Primary School Curriculum News September 2016

Year 5/6: Classes 7, 8 and 9

Areas of Study:

Our three classes will be completing a short history unit at the start of this term based on the 76 squadron. We will look at the association with Holme upon Spalding Moor and celebrate its centenary. After this we will be studying Europe with a focus on France and Paris in Geography. In Science, we will be covering Life Cycles and Evolution specifically focusing on the life cycle of plants. During R.E this term, the children will be exploring how different faiths express their beliefs. Alongside this, in PSHCE, we will be discussing Citizenship, Relationships, Personal Development and Lifestyles. Our Art will focus upon Still Life Painting. We will also continue with the learning of French.



Homework:

The Year 5 and Year 6 children will have maths homework each week, as well as their own individual spelling lists. Occasionally additional Grammar, punctuation and spelling work may be sent home in order for the children to consolidate their learning. Mathematics will continue to be an integral part of the children's homework and activities will be set regularly. For Big Maths, children also need to continue to practise their 'learn-it' facts and work on the quick recall of these.

We would also encourage regular reading with your child, which should be recorded in their Reading Record Book.
