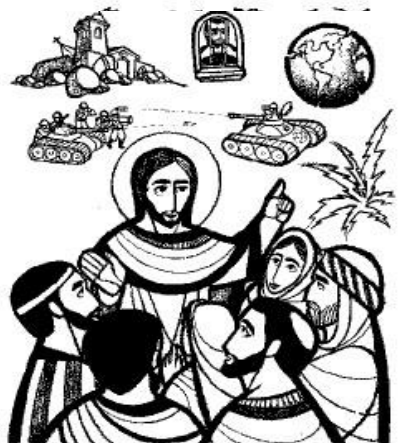
Psalter Week 1
