Our equality objectives are:

By July 2019, to increase the proportion of SEND pupils from the middle prior attainment band (KS1 results) who achieve the expected standard in reading, writing and maths.

By July 2019, to increase the proportion of high prior attainment band pupils (KS1 results) with a 2A for a particular subject, or who are in receipt of pupil premium, who achieve greater depth in reading, writing and maths.

By July 2019, to increase the proportion of middle prior attainment band pupils (KS1 results) with a level 1 or 2C for a particular subject, or who have English as an additional language or are in receipt of pupil premium, who achieve age related expectations in reading, writing and maths.
