

Staying Safe

With the dark nights well and truly upon us and as ever, more than our fair share of bad weather, it seems timely to draw attention to the need for us all to stay safe.

Firstly, we would strongly advise that children are collected from any after school clubs or activities.

Suggested general advice also includes:

- If picking up your children is not possible, encourage them to take the same familiar routes to and from school every day
- Whenever possible, children who walk to and from school should do so in a group.
- Avoid unlit areas
- Talk to them about how to react if they get lost
- Help us to reinforce the work we do about “stranger danger” and how to react if anyone approaches them

You will also be aware that there are two major construction projects in operation on either side of the school. These do present a danger with extra vehicles and people moving between the sites, and we would appreciate your support in ensuring that children are kept well away from these sites when they are in your care.
