

## E-Safety Curriculum Plan 2016-17

This will be taught as 6 focussed lessons, supplemented by frequent reminders as any internet devices are used or discussed.

Learning Objective	Resource (see e-safety folder in Staff shared drive on Server)	Follow-up Activity (for children to complete)
1. Ask if you're not sure - before you click!	Smartie the Penguin (e-book)	Make a hand, write a name of who to ask/talk to on each finger. Display & keep.
2. Should you accept the pop-up? (Always do what someone else wants?)	The Smart Crew (chapter 1) - link in e-safety folder	"Do it" game - whatever your partner says, you must do it! (teacher prepared cards)
3. Real grown-ups are behind every online character/avatar.	Lee and Kim video & discussion. - link in e-safety folder	Make a mask of any character you want to be. Who made it? Who's hiding behind it? Prepared photos of teachers in masks... who is it?
4. What information should you enter on a website?	Delivery for Webster (e-book) - pdf in e-safety folder	Game - What is your name? Where do you live? (Don't say) You lose a "life" if you tell a grown-up (game lasts all day) Keep your sweetie (secret info) wrapped up for a given period.
5. Should you share pictures online?	Digiduck (online e-book) - link in e-safety folder	Being nice online (discuss rules) don't tease or make fun, ask your trusted person (hand) Embarrassing baby photos... would you want your friends to see them?
6. What might happen to your information?	Hector's World (online story 4: Info Gang) - link in e-safety folder	Discuss your information and draw a web of where your information might go.

Additional content to emphasise:

- You should treat people online the same as in real life.
- If your mum/gran could see what you're doing, would they like it?
- Which devices can go on the internet? (change places game - picture cards of devices, change places if yours can go online. Change places if yours lets you talk to people.)
- Quick-links eg. Youtube: menu at the side which takes you away from your chosen content very quickly.
- Don't be click-happy!! Be click-smart!!
