

Ibstock Junior School Uniform

Our school uniform gives pupils a sense of unity and belonging. We want all our children to feel part of the school and for this reason we expect children to wear full school uniform at all times.



Our school uniform is:

Boys	Girls
White polo shirt (with or without logo)	White polo shirt (with or without logo)
Maroon sweatshirt with logo	Maroon sweatshirt or cardigan with logo
Black/Grey trousers (not jeans or joggers)	Black/grey skirt or trousers (not leggings, jeans or jeggings)
Black/grey shorts	A red summer gingham dress
Black shoes/ boots or completely black trainers without logos	Black shoes/ boots, or completely black trainers without logos
Black/grey or dark socks	Black/grey tights or socks

For PE kit pupils are expected to change into black shorts, white t-shirt and plimsolls/trainers for PE use only. For outdoor PE a tracksuit and trainers should also be provided. **This should be contained in a draw string bag as large rucksacks cannot be accommodated.** Please ensure children have their P.E kit in school every day, because PE days may change throughout the week. *We do insist that all uniform is clearly named - it makes it much easier to reunite lost items with their owner.*

Jewellery

For safety reasons children must not wear bracelets, brooches, rings and necklaces. Children may wear watches, but must be responsible for them. Children with pierced ears may wear stud earrings only (see below), but these must be removed for P.E and swimming. This is the child's responsibility. If earrings cannot be removed for a number of weeks then they should be taped with micro pore tape, this is the child's responsibility. Parents will be asked to sign a disclaimer in the office. Body/facial piercing is not permitted.

Make up

Make up, false nails and nail varnish should not be worn at school.

Hair Styles

Exaggerated or extreme haircuts are not permitted, including the wearing of large/additional hair accessories. If the length of the child's hair is impeding their learning it should be tied back at school. Long hair must be tied back for sporting activities.

Other equipment: Please ensure that your child's book bag and P.E. bag are a suitable size for school. Pencil cases, biro's, coloured pens and toys are not permitted in school. School will provide all writing and drawing materials.
