<p><b>Milestone 3</b></p> <p>To master techniques - Drawing.</p>	<p><b>Milestone 3</b></p> <p>Choose a style of drawing suitable for the work (e.g. realistic or impressionist).</p>	<p>Provide children with Worksheet 1A, enlarged to A3 size. Children colour the cityscape using bright felt tips. Cut the image out and glue onto black card. Children then trace around the trees and parts of the houses and colour them in. Glue the extra pieces on top of the original drawings.</p>	<p>Provide children with Task Card 1B and Cityscape Objects. Children re-create a similar picture to Fazzino's "In the centre of the apple" piece. Children need to colour in the buildings using bright felt tips. On an A3 piece of paper, children draw an island, rock or mountain outline on the bottom half of the page. They then cut out their houses and glue them onto the curved shape. To make it 3D, children glue some crumpled-up newspaper to the back of each image before gluing them down.</p>	<p>Children use examples of Fazzino's work to create their own 3D Cityscape. Children need to draw their design onto A3 paper. They then choose some buildings and objects to replicate and make 3D. They objects they choose to make 3D will be glued on top of the original. Children will glue crumpled-up newspaper to the cut-out version first. Then they will glue it onto the original drawing to make it 3D.</p>	<p>PowerPoint slides Worksheet 1A and Task Card 1B Cityscape Objects Coloured felts A3 paper, newspaper PVA glue and scissors</p>
