

Literacy:

We will read a range of information books about people who help us, looking at the features of non-fiction texts and using the contents pages to find information. We will then think of our own questions to ask our visitors and use what we find out to write our own information and information books. We will continue to have phonics lessons to help us to learn and use new sounds and words through fun games and activities.

Maths:

We will be counting, comparing, recognising and writing numbers to 20 and beyond. We will be practising our estimating and investigating ordinal numbers (1st, 2nd, 3rd etc). We will also be adding up to 10 and then 20 in different ways. We will be sorting different objects and shapes using different criteria and will investigate symmetry and pattern.

Physical development:

We will be investigating moving and balancing in different ways and use these in different games and activities.

Personal, social and emotional development:

We will be thinking about our friends and how we care for each other.



Expressive arts and design:

This term we will be turning large boxes into life size emergency vehicles and will be painting the different people who help us to go inside!

In music we will be investigating making different sounds made by emergency vehicles and using these to accompany stories about them.

Understanding the World:

This term we will be finding out about different celebrations including New Year, Chinese New Year and the Hindu colour festival of Holi. We will be using the i-pads to draw Chinese dragons and colourful Holi pictures.

We will find out about how vehicles work and look in particular at wheels and how they move. We will use what we find out to design and make our own emergency vehicles out of cardboard boxes. We will also be finding out about our bodies and our teeth.

We will find out about emergency jobs in the past and look at similarities and differences.
