Hi, my name is Joshua and I'm from year 3. I like being an ambassador because it's fun and I like teaching other children about rights.

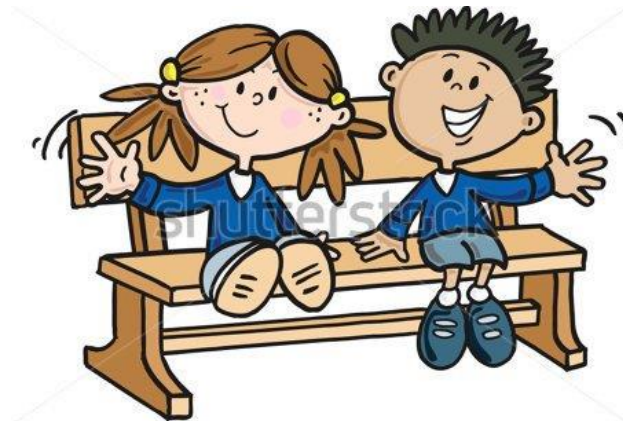


Freya

Grammar signs



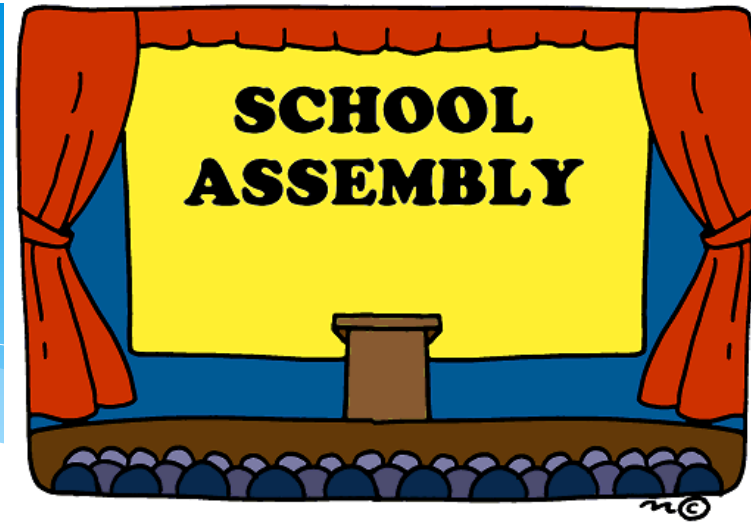
- * Around our school, we decided where to put up the grammar signs.
