We have found some children to be bringing aerosols into school (hair spray, deodorant and even hair colours); if your child requires deodorant during the school day (Years 5 & 6) they may bring the roll on variety as the aerosols are highly flammable and a serious fire hazard in school. Hair colour spray is not to be brought into school.

Whilst we understand that there are times when it cannot be helped, we have seen a marked increase in the number of children regularly arriving late for school. The junior school children should be in school by 8.45am and for the infants it is 8.55am.

If your child is late they MUST be signed in correctly at the office, detailing the reason why. We keep records of all pupils' attendance and have to enter a reason for lateness; if we have no reason given then this will be kept on file. If a pupil is regularly late, this will be picked up by the Education Welfare Officer and may incur a fine.

If you leave a message on the pupil absence answerphone can you please state your child's name, class and FULL reason for absence eg: high temperature and cold, sickness and diarrhoea etc as we need this information for the records we have to keep.
