Funding for School

Can we ask that if parents think their child is entitled to Free School Meals, they advise the school office, as it would benefit the school greatly. You can make us aware **at any time**. We are aware that every child is entitled to a universal free meal at school, however, the school would receive extra funds for your child, which would help us to continue to provide a broad and exciting curriculum. We will be sending out a form very soon that we would appreciate you complete, whether you know your child would be eligible or not. For every child entitled to a free school meal we receive **£1320** per year which helps us to maintain our high standards. Feel free to come into the school office if you would like further assistance with this matter.



Care plans

If for any reason your child is, or has been unwell and needs a care plan in school, we ask you to contact the office to arrange a meeting with a trained member of staff.



As a busy school we ask that care plans are completed with a parent/carer and staff member between the hours of **8:00-8:30 am or 3:00-3:30 pm**. Please contact the school office to arrange an appointment. For health and safety reasons can we also advise that medication should **never** be put in a child's bag to come to school.
