I am sure you will all recall that at the beginning of this term Trinity Church School had its first monitoring visit from OFSTED to check on how well we were doing in our work to improve the school. Attached is the letter we have now received following this visit and I am delighted to tell you that it is extremely positive. In fact, the letter is about as positive as it could be given the constraints HMI are under with the template they must use.

Children, staff and parents/carers should be very proud of the progress made and the improvements seen in a short space of time. It is very clear that the school is well on its way to being judged 'good' or better within the next 12 months.

The OFSTED team who visited were impressed with the pace at which safeguarding had been secured, improvements to governance /leadership at all levels and improvements in the quality of teaching and learning and assessment. There was praise too for work being done to 'ensure children catch up quickly'. In the letter was significant praise for the Midsomer Norton Schools' Partnership, who have provided strong support across all aspects of the work undertaken by the school, something that will continue this coming year and beyond. Leaders in the school were also praised for their astute management of the issues that were facing the school last year.

As with all schools, there are still things to continue working on, but inspectors were genuinely impressed with the school and I hope will visit again soon to see yet more excellent progress. Thank you to parents and carers for your support. Inspectors did manage to speak to a number of parents during their visit and feedback to OFSTED was exceptionally positive.
