Dear Parent/Carer,

I am planning a trip to Bhaktivedanta Manor Temple in Watford as part of our RE work on Hinduism. It is a temple in Watford that offers a day's educational activities, as well as a visit to a working Hindu Temple.

We will be leaving by coach on Friday 28th April at 9am and will return to school by 3.15pm. The children need to wear normal school uniform with a waterproof coat. Lunch will be provided and is included in the cost.

At the Manor the children will experience various activities, a presentation and tour of the Hindu Temple, Role play and dressing up. Then after lunch they will be seeing the Shrine and experiencing how Hindus worship, face painting and a trip to the souvenir shop (the children may bring up to £3 each to spend in a sealed envelope with their name clearly labelled on the front.)

The cost of the full day trip, including coach travel and lunch will be £19.80. Previous Year 4 children have been on this trip before and it really is a very worthwhile experience for the class. They will be seeing first hand all the things we have been learning about in school. (Further information about the day will follow nearer the trip date.)
