'They are kind'	Theo



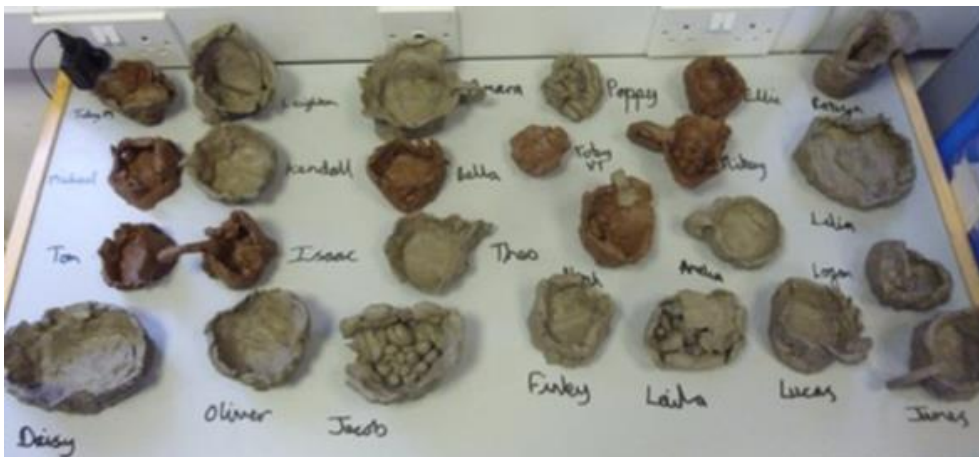
The children talked about how people choose their friends and what qualities a good friend would have. After that, they heard how Jesus chose his Disciples.
