In the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) we follow the Statutory Framework for the EYFS. Our school fully supports the principle that young children learn through play, and by engaging in well-planned and structured activities. Our curriculum planning focuses on the needs and interests of the children based on the Early Years Outcomes for the prime areas

- Communication and Language CL
- Physical Development PD
- Personal, Social and Emotional Development

And specific areas

- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding the World
- Expressive Arts and Design

Each half term, teachers alongside key workers, assess the development of each child against the Early Years Outcomes. This assessment forms an important part of the future curriculum planning for each child and is the basis of each half terms medium term plan. As a result the provision offers a range of adult led activities and enhancements to promote learning opportunities.
