Netball Club



Our netball club was established in September 2011 and it has been growing year on year. We are affiliated to England Netball.

In 2015 YMCA netball club was awarded a Bronze CAPS award by England Netball. This prestigious accreditation is only given to clubs who can demonstrate that they are offering a good quality netball provision within their community. CAPS is aligned to the Sport England Clubmark accreditation scheme which is the only National cross sports quality accreditation scheme for clubs with junior sections. It is built around a set of core criteria which ensure that accredited clubs operate to a set of consistent, accepted and adopted minimum operating standards.

- ▶ Our club provides coaching sessions for all players from 7 years old to adults. We have professionally qualified coaches at each session who are DBS cleared, experienced and aim to provide quality sessions in a safe environment.
- ▶ We are extremely fortunate to have a Sports Hall with an indoor court built to England Netball specifications and also 2 outdoor courts with floodlighting.
- ▶ New members are invited to attend our training sessions each Thursday at specified times. These sessions give new member who may not have played the game before, or others that may want to train outside school in a club setting, an introduction to netball. Sessions are aimed at improving basic skills and developing an understanding of the game of netball.
- ▶ Older players or ladies returning to netball are also welcome along on each Thursday evening to take part in a 'fun' netball session.



Wednesday sessions are for our squad players and these are aimed at improving players' netball skills and transferring these skills to their matches. We work on team set pieces and linking play throughout the court. These members compete in the West Yorkshire League and train each Wednesday at specified times depending upon age.

We compete at U11s, U12s, U14s and U16s age groups in the West Yorkshire Junior League and at senior level in the West Yorkshire League. We also compete in the annual West Yorkshire U11s and U12s tournaments.

Part of the commitment to playing for YMCA Netball Club is that all members must be affiliated to England Netball by completing the Affiliation Form. Members must attend weekly training sessions or let the head coach know in advance if this is not possible. Junior members must be available for Sunday matches which take place at various venues throughout West Yorkshire. If they cannot play the head coach needs to be informed in advance. Senior members must be available for Saturday matches which also take place at various venues throughout West Yorkshire. Squad members must have the club playing kit and this is available to purchase by completing the order form.
