The purpose of our service is to offer a bespoke provision which is personalised to each individual on roll. Upon arrival pupils will receive a 12-week intervention programme with a clear and defined exit strategy, agreed by associated stakeholders, in accordance with our policies and procedures. Our aim as a school is to challenge pupils to take responsibility, modify their behaviour, improve attitude to school life and make academic progress across the range and breadth of curriculum opportunities available. In addition to classroom based learning, pupils are provided with enrichment opportunities, with high quality learning outside the classroom planned throughout the academic year. We believe in lifelong learning and endeavour to support social and emotional development as well as academic improvements. We challenge pupils to believe in themselves to be the best they can be.
