In the meantime Chloe and Sarah have offered to take over the programme arrangements, which is really appreciated. Tracy has all the information on a USB stick. Sarah will start to ring around the advertisers after the Easter break and Chloe will arrange the layout of the programme. Sarah has approached the organisers of Trevalga Fete for some ideas of different games to use on the day. Table skittles is a possibility and a suggestion of how many of an item into a bottle.

Any other business:

Steve C and Julie have put together a piece to put in the Boscastle Blowhole to advertise the School Association events. We will have a space in each issue to let the village know what we are up to.

Race for Life - we will be arranging a fundraising event to support the Cancer research race for life. Julie has contacted the football club and they have said we can use the football pitch to hold it. The provisional date is 9th April. This will be confirmed asap. There will be a bake sale to raise money and teas and coffees.

There will be a small entrance fee of £1 per child to take part, this will go toward Cancer research to cover the event packs. Each child will receive a medal at the end of the race. Each age group will have their own individual race, a distance that they should be able to complete. Julie will set up a Facebook event so we can share it amongst friends and local schools. We have sponsor forms, which each runner will be issued with so they can raise money if they wish. We will need to know rough numbers by 22nd March so we can order the medals.
