- arrange for opportunities to meet teachers regularly during which learning and progress will be discussed;
- keep parents informed about school activities through regular letters home via email, texting and updating the school website;
- listen to and discuss parents' concerns.

- let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's learning or behaviour;
- support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour;

- support my child in home learning tasks and other opportunities for home learning;

- get to know about my child's life at the school.
