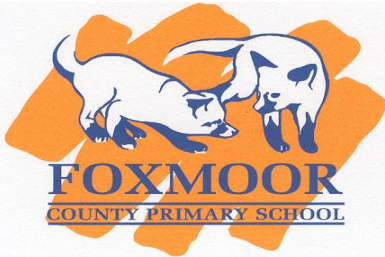

## PE

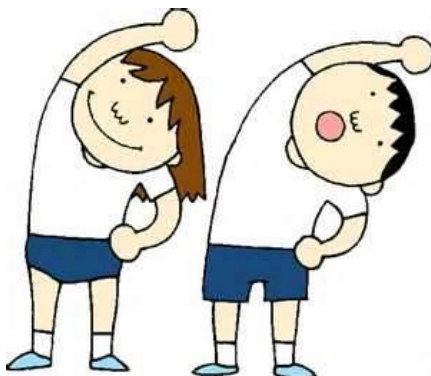
