

Safety at the Gate

Could parents please be aware of members of the public and other families using the footpath outside the school gates? We have had complaints regarding access through and around groups of parents blocking the path, especially near the playground gate. Many users are elderly people, including those with disabilities. Access through the double gates to the car park **must** be kept clear at all times, for the use of emergency vehicles, which was the case yesterday morning. Under no circumstances are parents permitted to park in the school car park. It has also been noted that parents are double parking, particularly on the bridge which makes it difficult for the emergency services, buses and other road users to get through. Parking on zig-zag lines is illegal, the Highway Code (Rule 238) states 'You **MUST NOT** wait or park, or stop to set down and pick up passengers, on school entrance markings'. Please park and wait considerately to avoid unnecessary problems or accidents. Thank you.
