Year 5 Residential 2017 – Robinwood – The Old School, Todmorden, Lancashire

In the autumn term, we arrange for every child in year 5 to take part in a residential visit. This offers all pupils a wonderful opportunity to learn new skills and develop their experiences of outdoor and adventurous activities, with the emphasis being on promoting healthy physical exercise as well as developing team-building and self-confidence.

We visited 'The Old School' Robinwood centre, in Todmorden last year and following lots of positive feedback from parents and pupils of the current Year 5, we have decided to visit this centre once more. Robinwood have been a provider of adventurous activities for more than thirty years; all of the exciting activities are based on site at Robinwood and are operated by fully qualified instructors; all activities have been fully risk assessed.

We have reserved the centre for the following dates in 2017 as follows:

Monday 4th – Wednesday 6th December 2017 (62 pupils)
Wednesday 6th – Friday 8th December 2017 (62 pupils)


The cost of this residential visit comprising of accommodation, food, all activities (£116) and a voluntary contribution for transport (approximately £14) will be approximately £130. We will be offering a payment schedule from April to December 2017, but would be pleased to arrange weekly or monthly payment plans for those wishing to pay this way. Those parents in receipt of certain benefits, listed overleaf, may be exempt from part of the payment.

Although an information booklet accompanies this letter, there will be a Parents' Meeting during the summer term, where you will be given more detailed information and the opportunity to ask questions about the residential visit. If you require any additional information before this time, please contact Miss Binns at school.

Please return the slip at the end of this letter to the school, by Wednesday 29th March confirming your child's attendance on the visit and that a £20 deposit has been paid using ParentPay.

- Income Support (IS);
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA);
- support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999;
- Child Tax Credit, provided that Working Tax Credit is not also received and the family's income (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs) does not exceed £15,910 (Financial Year 2015/16);
- the guarantee element of State Pension Credit; and
- an income related employment and support allowance that was introduced on 27 October 2008.
