**7pm-8pm 4<sup>th</sup> April 2017**



- Sutton Coldfield schools will lose £8,500,000 in real terms by 2020.
- This will mean an average funding loss of £554 per pupil.
- This equates to an average of 15 fewer teachers in our secondary schools and an average of 4 fewer teachers in our primary schools.

The result will be:

- increased class sizes • reduced subject choice • teacher job losses
- support staff job losses • fewer resources • less support for pupils
- Parents, governors, headteachers and school staff need to unite and demand that the Government funds our schools properly.
