Attendance: Please can I remind you how important good attendance is for your child's learning. You will see a percentage of attendance on your child's report. Sometimes absence cannot be avoided, but all the odd days add up quickly. Any percentage below 97.5% is below the national expectation. Below 95% would be seen as 'poor.' 90% or below is a serious concern, and I will be investigating those next term. I will not grant any absence requests unless there is a very serious reason. Any pre-booked holidays made by parents or other relatives will not be granted, neither will odd days or a day for travelling or for an extended weekend break. Absence for sports competitions or external exams in music, ballet etc. are considered separately
